

I am writing to refer an issue to you for investigation. A whistleblower is alleging the possible purging and deletion of over 10,000 veteran's health records at the Health Eligibility Center in Atlanta, Georgia. In addition, the whistleblower is alleging a backlog of 600,000 pending benefit enrollment applications and 40,000 unprocessed applications discovered in January 2013 that span a three year time period. I respectfully request that you open an investigation into this matter and determine what further action should be taken.
